## At the Airport

### Going Through Security



No liquids, aerosols, or gels **over 3 oz/100 mL** in your carry-on bags.



Pack large electronics like laptops in **easy-to-access spots**.



**Discard or empty** water bottles before going through security.



Be mindful of your clothing. Wear slip-on shoes, and try to avoid clothes with metal buttons or snaps.



Arrive 2 to 2.5 hours early. Boarding begins 30-60 minutes before, and doors can close up to 30 minutes before your flight.

#### **QUICK TIP**

If you're not checking luggage, you can skip the check-in counter completely with a mobile boarding pass!

Once you find your gate, take a deep breath and *relax!* Wake youself up with some coffee, have a smoothie, or drink an alcoholic beverage to help soothe any jitters.

## Hit the Road (Trip)

When you're road-tripping solo, you want to know some car care basics, like **how to change a tire and how to check and add oil** - there are plenty of online tutorials that will teach you how! Keep a local tow company's phone number handy, just in case.

### Road Trip Reminders



Make sure your **spare tire** is in good condition; learn how to **here**!



**Print instructions** (like **these** on how to change a tire!) and keep them in your car.



**Get an emergency roadside kit** to help you accomplish your car care feats.

**Bring snacks!** Road trips are the perfect time to splurge on your favorite treats.

Remember a **good pair of sunglasses** that will protect your eyes and help reduce strain.

Consider a **holder for your cell phone** that you can attach to your windshield or dashboard so you can keep your eyes up while using your GPS or skipping a song.

Don't forget a **portable phone charger**, **aux cord**, **and dongle**.

Download audiobooks or podcasts for the drive!

### Restaurants + Bars

## Accommodations + Activities




Plan a few things to do, and set aside time to be spontaneous: stroll in the park, wander the main square, window shop... take in your destination!



Book a group tour: see an attraction a bit out of the city, take a food tour, or cruise the best wine spots in town. You might even befriend other travelers!



Be flexible: it's okay to make a plan and change your mind later. This is your solo trip, so do what you want, when you want!

## Packing for Solo Travel

### Things to Remember

<b>Bring a journal</b> to jot down what you did that day, funny things that happened, whatever you want so that you'll always be able to look back on your Trip!
<b>Be mindful of your valuables</b> , like expensive jewelry and electronics. If your hotel room has a safe, use it when leaving the room.
<b>Pack light</b> so you can travel with ease. Packing cubes and compression bags are perfect for staying organized and making good use of space.
<b>Bring a charger</b> for your phone and/or camera so you never run out of juice.
Consider a selfie stick or a portable tripod for your phone or camera. Sometimes there won't be someone around to take a picture for you, or you might not want to rely on the photography skills of a stranger to get the perfect shot.
Carry a reusable water bottle! It's good for you, good for the planet, and you can carry it empty through airport security, then fill it up later.
<b>Bring a book</b> that you have been meaning to read so you always have an activity to fill your time.

## Staying Safe

### Carrying Valuables



If you carry a bag, choose a **crossbody style** that can't be grabbed off your shoulder. Always keep it zipped and towards your front.



Keep valuables out of your back pockets.

### Location, Location



Before you depart for your Solo Trip, let someone know **which city and hotel you're going to and when you'll back**. Consider sharing your location on your phone with a friend or family member.



**Always be aware of your surroundings**. It can be tempting to put on headphones when walking around town, but it's better to stay alert and present.

### Personal Documents



**Scan copies of your IDs, insurance cards, etc.,** and save them to your phone and email in case they get lost or misplaced.



If you have more than one credit/debit card, **leave one hidden** in your luggage or the safe at your hotel in case you lose one.
